Parker's Hall was built for John Parker, who was a merchant and later President of the Grass Valley Board of trustees in 1875. In the late 1800s and early 1900s, 112 Mill Street was occupied by a shoe store, the Philadelphia Shoe Store (John Best & Henry Luke), later to be named Best's Shoes (Samuel and John Best). Luke came to Grass Valley in 1866 from England and mined for the next 17 years until 1883, when he joined John Best in the boot and shoe business. In 1891, Luke sold his interest in the store to his partner and went into the drygoods business, the People's Cash Store. The shoe store later became Pengelley's and was a photography studio in the 1960s-1990s (City of Grass Valley Historical Files).







Lloyd Street was named for Thomas Lloyd, who built several houses on that street. In the 1890s the building was occupied by a drygoods store. Pacific Telephone & Telegraph had an office in the building in 1910. By the late 1960s and 1970s it was a tavern (City of Grass Valley Historical Files).


