

## **HEALTH ALERT!**

## **SEPTEMBER 15, 2025**

The Nevada County Environmental Health Department (NCEHD) is issuing this <u>HEALTH ALERT</u> to all residents and visitors of Nevada County.

This advisory is issued solely by Nevada County and is not connected to any State or Federal enforcement action. Our intent is to safeguard the health of our residents and visitors by providing clear, factual, information to support informed choices regarding food consumption.

We urge the public to exercise caution when considering consuming food from vendors operating without proper health permits. Food prepared outside of permitted facilities may pose serious health risks, including exposure to potentially life-threatening pathogens such as Clostridium perfringens, Campylobacter jejuni, Clostridium botulinum, Salmonella, Staphylococcus aureus, Norovirus, and Hepatitis A.

The NCEHD remains committed to protecting public health and ensuring that all food consumed in our community meets safety standards. We appreciate your partnership in maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all.

Nevada County Environmental Health Department is working closely with local law enforcement, County Counsel and our District Attorney's Office to shut down these operations for public health and safety.
