Title: Collection of delinquent sewer only accounts on the Nevada County tax roll

Agenda: Public Hearing

Recommended Motion: After holding a public hearing, adopt Resolution 2009-65 requesting that the County of Nevada levy and collect delinquent sewer service charges on the tax roll.

Background Information: Health and Safety Code Section 5473 authorizes the City to place delinquent sewer service charges on the tax roll for collection after the approval by a two-thirds vote by the members of the City's legislative body. This is done in the same manner as property taxes are handled. The City uses this option for sewer only accounts where service cannot be discontinued as a collection method. Since the County started using the teeter plan for the distribution of tax revenues, the City has been receiving sewer bills placed on the tax roll even if the property owner doesn't pay the tax bill. The method is very effective and allows the City to collect charges from customers that have not made payment.

All affected property owners have been notified as required by the Health and Safety Code. Any amounts received from customers prior to submitting this request will be removed from the list.

The delinquent amount as of June 18, 200 is \$16,363.52
