

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-80

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRASS VALLEY
REMOVING A RESTRICTED PARKING ZONE ON
MAINHART DRIVE**

WHEREAS, Section 22507 of the Vehicle Code of the State of California specifies that local authorities may, by ordinance or resolution, prohibit or restrict the stopping, parking, or standing of vehicles on certain streets or highways, during all or certain hours of the day; and

WHEREAS, Mainhart Drive is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the City of Grass Valley; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Review Committee recommends the removal of a “no parking” zone on Mainhart Drive;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council for the City of Grass Valley as follows:

1. That the foregoing statements are true and correct.
2. That the City Council of the City of Grass Valley, in accordance with the provisions of Section 22507 of the Vehicle Code of the State of California, remove the following parking zone on:
 - a. Mainhart Drive – a no parking zone, approximately 20 feet in length, between the driveways of 102/104 Mainhart Drive and 116 Mainhart Drive.
3. That the Engineering Division be directed to update the Restricted Parking Map of the City of Grass Valley by removal of the parking zone as set forth hereinabove.
