

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-08

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF GRASS VALLEY
DECLARING THREE (3) POLICE VEHICLES TO BE SURPLUS,
AUTHORIZING DISPOSITION OF SAID EQUIPMENT AND
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) REPLACEMENT
VEHICLE.**

WHEREAS, the City Council may, pursuant to Government Code Section 37350, from time to time declare as surplus property certain personal property of the City which for reasons of wear and tear, defect or obsolescence becomes unsatisfactory or unsafe to use; and

WHEREAS, whenever the Council declares such personal property as surplus it may dispose of same when said disposal is for the benefit of the City and its constituents; and

WHEREAS, the Grass Valley Police Department has advised the City Council that the 1994 Ford Ranger, VIN#F1FTCR10U4RUD28071, marked vehicle for the Animal Control Department, the 2005 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W05X138086, marked vehicle for the patrol unit, and the 2003 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAHP71W53X152233, unmarked vehicle for the volunteer unit, are no longer satisfactory for use by the City's Police Department; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to acquire a replacement vehicle for patrol; and

WHEREAS, the Grass Valley Police Department has been awarded a Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$34,866 to purchase a new patrol vehicle; and

WHEREAS, staff has requested that the declaration of surplus and disposal of said surplus vehicles be in conjunction with the acquisition of a replacement vehicle; and

WHEREAS, Winner Chevrolet has offered to sell to the City a 2010 Chevrolet Tahoe, less trade-in of the 1994 Ford Ranger, VIN#F1FTCR10U4RUD28071, the 2005 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAFP71W05X138086, and the 2003 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN#2FAHP71W53X152233, including tax for \$31,989.25.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRASS VALLEY, as follows:

1. That the foregoing statements are true and correct.
2. That the City Council finds that the 1994 Ford Ranger, 2005 Ford Crown Victoria, and 2003 Ford Crown Victoria to be surplus and finds that the disposal of said vehicles are for the benefit of the City and its constituents.

3. That this declaration of surplus and disposal of said surplus vehicles shall be in conjunction with the acquisition of the 2010 Chevrolet Tahoe and the incidentals necessary therefore to:
