

## **GLENN JONES PARK INFORMATION**

**993 Allison Ranch Road (intersection of Mill Street, Freeman Lane and McCourtney Road)**

### **FACILITY INFORMATION**

Glenn Jones Park is a 2-acre pocket park with picnic tables located next to the Pelton Wheel Mining Museum along Wolf Creek. The park's hours are dawn to dusk and it is equipped with 2 restrooms (located inside the museum), 6 picnic tables (8' concrete), and 2 trash cans.

The museum is operated by the Nevada County Historical Society, May 15 - October 15, 10 A.M. – 5 P.M. daily. Restrooms are only available during the museum operating hours.

Parking includes: 28 spaces (1 handicapped) shared with the museum. Parking availability is not guaranteed and may be limited due to other events in the park.

Renters are responsible for clean-up. All tables cleared, garbage bagged and placed at the rear of the museum. Renters must supply their own garbage bags. The signature on the agreement will be that of the responsible person. Failure to clean the facility to the requirements of the post-inspection form may result in loss of deposit and/or additional charges.

**RESERVATION INFORMATION:** Reservations will be taken on a first come, first served basis at Grass Valley City Hall, 125 East Main Street, Grass Valley, CA, 95945 (274-4350), Monday - Friday 8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M. Inquiries can be made in person or by telephone. An inquiry is not considered a confirmed reservation.

Cancellations must be made through the Public Works Administrative Clerk 14 days in advance of the rental date to receive a full refund of the rental fees and security/cleaning deposits that have been paid, less the current cancellation fee.

**FEE:** Daily rental \$97.00

**DEPOSIT:** \$100.00 refundable security deposit. Additional deposit may be required depending on the nature of the event.
