

CONDON PARK

660 Minnie Street (corner of Minnie Street and Butler Street)

FACILITY INFORMATION

Condon Park is an 80 acre Regional Park with a disc golf course, skate park, bocce ball courts, baseball fields, walking trails, arboretum, reception hall, and two group BBQ areas and individual picnic sites. While park hours are dawn to dusk, certain facilities have specific hours of operation. Amenities include: restrooms (adjacent to disc golf course, group picnic area and ball fields), drinking fountains (located next to ball fields, disc golf course, skate park, and group BBQ area), bicycle rack (located at disc golf course). Miscellaneous space can be reserved only under a Special Use Permit.

Park Rules: Park Rules & Regulations are posted at the entrance to the facility.

Parking includes: 29 spaces (2 handicapped) adjacent to disc golf course, 10 spaces (1 handicapped) adjacent to skate park, 36 spaces (1 handicapped) adjacent to baseball field, 30 spaces (1 handicapped) adjacent to BBQ area, and 30 spaces (1 handicapped) adjacent to the L.O.V.E. building. Parking availability is not guaranteed and may be limited due to other events.

Renters are responsible for clean-up. All tables must be cleared, garbage bagged and placed in dumpsters. Renters must supply their own garbage bags. The signature on the agreement will be that of the responsible person. Additional charges may apply if clean-up requirements are not met.

**The park was donated to the City in 1957 by Lulu Condon. In December 1981, the Recreation Department at California State University, Chico, prepared a "Master Plan" for the development of Condon Park. Various community service organizations have contributed to the development of this park.*

RESERVATION INFORMATION: Miscellaneous space can be reserved under special conditions at Grass Valley City Hall, 125 East Main Street, Grass Valley, CA, 95945 (274-4373), Monday - Friday 8:00 A.M. - 4:00 P.M. Inquiries can be made in person or by telephone. An inquiry is not considered a confirmed reservation.

Cancellations must be made through the Public Works Administrative Clerk 14 days in advance of the rental date to receive a full refund of the rental fees and security/cleaning deposits which have been paid; less the current cancellation fee.

RENTAL FEE: Daily rental \$200.00

DEPOSIT: \$100.00 refundable security deposit. Additional deposit may be required depending on the nature of the event.
