

MEMORIAL PARK CLUB HOUSE

415 Memorial Lane, Memorial Park

FACILITY INFORMATION

The Memorial Park Club House is an 800 sq. ft. meeting hall which can accommodate 30 people seated and 65 people assembly. It is not available for rent, but may be used under a Facility Use Agreement. The Club House comes equipped with 3 - 8' tables and 20 folding chairs.

*Park Rules: Park Rules & Regulations are posted at the entrance to the Facility.
Smoking is not permitted in the facility.*

Parking includes: 36 spaces (0 handicap) adjacent to playground, and 4 spaces (1 handicap) adjacent to Memorial Tennis Courts. Parking availability is not guaranteed and may be limited due to other events in the park.

Tables and chairs are available for indoor use only. When setting up for the rental, renters should not drag the tables and chairs across the floor. Storage is not available either before or after the event without prior arrangements. Animals, other than service dogs, are not permitted in the facility /park area.

**The Memorial Park Club House was originally built in 1921 by the Idaho-Maryland Mining Company. The building was used for many community social events. In 1956 the building was modified to create an office for the Recreation Director and living quarters for the Park Caretaker. The building was modified again in 2005 to provide offices for the Recreation & Facility Manager and Park Ranger.*
