The Animal Control Officer will enforce municipal ordinances and State Law governing the keeping of animals within the City jurisdiction; and to impound, care for, and properly dispose of animals. Duties include (but not limited to):

- \* Assist the public and answer questions regarding laws, rules, and regulations pertaining to animal control and the shelter
- \* Patrol assigned areas, picking up animals in violation of City ordinances;
- \* Investigate complaints of nuisance animals and write reports;
- \* Issue warning notices and citations;
- \* Investigate inhumane treatment of animals;
- \* Investigate animal bites and quarantine animals as required by State Law;
- \* Feed and care for all animals housed at the shelter;
