The Grass Valley Police Department is committed to reducing crime and improving the quality of life in our community

The Community Service Officer (CSO) is distinguished from a Police Officer in that the CSO is a non-sworn officer who assists sworn personnel by performing non-hazardous law enforcement and public safety duties.

Some Typical Duties Include:

- * Patrol areas of the city to enforce parking, vehicle abatement, code violations, etc.
- * Provide support to patrol, detectives, animal control, and other police divisions
- * Investigate non-injury traffic collisions
- * Prepare non-emergency theft, stolen car, missing person, vandalism, and other reports
- * Assist with special events in the city
- * Perform traffic control and non-violent crowd control



Requirements:

- * Equivalent to the completion of the twelfth grade
- * Valid CA driver's license & acceptable driving record
- * Able to obtain a PC 832 certificate within 6 months of hire
- * Must pass comprehensive background check
- * CSO II – Minimum of one year experience as a CSO I
