

Proposed Sewer Rates - Residential bills include a fixed monthly charge for sewer service. Commercial bills include a flat monthly charge plus a quantity charge based on customer class and water consumption. The January 2006 adjustment includes rate structure modifications to address rate equity. Rate increases in subsequent years will apply across-the-board and affect all customers by the same proportion. Proposed sewer rates are listed below.
