

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING


Notice is hereby given that the City of Grass Valley City Council will hold a public hearing on June 14, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter described herein may be heard by the Council at the Grass Valley City Council Chambers, 125 East Main Street, Grass Valley, California, concerning:

1. Annual assessment for fiscal year 2022/2023 - Landscaping and Lighting District No. 1988-1 Commercial Landscaping and Lighting District - Whispering Pines Subdivision and Litton Business Park.
2. Annual assessment for fiscal year 2022/2023 - Landscaping and Lighting District No. 1988-2 Residential Landscaping and Lighting District - Morgan Ranch, Ventana Sierra, Scotia Pines and Morgan Ranch West and Ridge Meadows Subdivisions.
3. Annual assessment for fiscal year 2022/2023 – Benefit Assessment District No. 2003-1 - Morgan Ranch Unit 7.
4. Annual assessment for fiscal year 2022/2023 – Benefit Assessment District No. 2010-1 – Morgan Ranch West.
5. Annual assessment for fiscal year 2022/2023 – Benefit Assessment District No. 2016-1 – Ridge Meadows
6. Administrative Proposed Budget for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the City of Grass Valley and including the Operating Budget for the Grass Valley Redevelopment Successor Agency, that is included as supplemental information to the Administrative Proposed budget of the City of Grass Valley.
7. Appropriation Limit for The City of Grass Valley for fiscal year 2022-2023, as required by Article XIII B of the California Constitution.

The Council, thereafter, shall take whatever final action it determines necessary and appropriate on these matters. If you challenge the Council's action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearings described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Council at, or prior to, the public hearings.
